I'm married & my sex drive has decreased. Should I seek medical help?

There is usually nothing medically wrong

with not wanting to have sex. Not wanting to have sex is as natural as wanting to have it. It may have more to do with psyche than it does medical, though it could be a medical reason. Seek-

ing medical help couldn't hurt, but before making that leap, consider a few things. First, remember what you did that heightened your desires, rekindle those moments & then keep it interesting by mixing it up. If your spouse was the one to plan dates, then you take the initiative & plan them. If your spouse was the one who usually makes the first move, then you make the first move. After
